Entry Deadline:	June 3, 2010
Entry Fee:	\$25 per person, capped at \$450 (No Personal Checks Please) Cash or Money Orders/Cashier's Checks payable to McCollum Alumni Softball Tournament. This is a non-refundable entrance fee due the night of the drawing.
Umpire Fees:	\$15 per Class (or team), per umpire, per game.
Awards:	1 ST , 2 ND and 3 RD
Type:	Single Bracket/Double Elimination
Tournament Draw:	Thursday, June 3, 2010, 7:00 p.m.
Tournament Play Begins:	Saturday, June 5, 2010, 8:00 a.m.
Tournament Site:	Rusty Lyons Softball Complex (Basse & McCullough a/k/a Olmos Park)
Uniforms:	Classes to supply team shirts if desired.
Roster:	24 players (allowable team make-ups listed below), See forms provided or contact Tournament Director
Score Keepers:	Teams will keep score with umpires. Home team is responsible for keeping official scorebook and reporting/returning results back to the MAST table.
Balls:	A.S.A. approved balls (with A.S.A. logo red stitch legible). MFP core .44, Restricted Flight, 12-inch men, and 11-inch women. MAST will sell Tournament Balls to all teams participating.
Run Rule:	A 20 run rule will be in effect after 3½ or 4 innings of play/12 run rule for 4½ or 5 innings.
Home Team:	Will be decided by the toss of a coin. Home team will occupy third base dugout.
Time Limit:	50 minutes
Line-Ups:	Line-ups are due ten (10) minutes prior to scheduled game time and are to be exchanged between teams and acknowledged to the Umpire.
Game Time:	Game time is forfeit time.
Protests:	As per A.S.A. guidelines, final say by behind plate umpire.
Rain Delay/Suspension:	Per ASA rules, e.g., best record, head-to-head competition, etc.
Conduct of Players:	Unsportsmanlike conduct by any team member or spectator will not be tolerated and is cause for disqualification of the player, manager and/or team. Reinstatement will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

13th Annual McCollum Alumni Softball Tournament Rules:

1. Umpire/Tournament Directors decisions are final.
2. Tournament is considered to be D-League Co-Ed ASA rules.
 - a. Walking a Male - If a male is intentionally walked, next female walks after the 2ND out only.
 - b. Home Runs – Batter must only tag first base. All runners on base must run the remaining bases.
 - c. Home Runs - Only two (2) over-the-fence home runs per team, per game. After two over-the-fence home runs, all other over-the-fence home runs will automatically be an out.
3. Teams will be Co-Ed. Maximum of 24 players per team. Allowable team make-ups listed below.
4. Only McCollum alumni and their spouses are allowed to play (no children, dependents, etc.). Up to 5 spouses of alumni may participate per team. If a spouse plays, the alumni must play one inning. If the alumni gets injured and cannot play, in general, the spouse cannot play. Alumni and spouse must be in the dugout/dugout area for that entire game.
5. Teams may use McCollum alumni from class's two years prior and two years after their graduating class. Teams that have reached the 20 year mark from their graduation date may start looking three years prior and three years after the graduating class for additional team members. Teams that have reached the 30 year mark from their graduation date may start looking four years prior and four years after the graduating class for additional team members. An alumni wishing to play on a team which is not his graduating class, must obtain a written release from the Team Captain of their graduating class stating the Team Captain has released that alumni and/or stating their team has sufficient players on the roster to release the alumni. The Tournament Director will approve all instances in advance.

6. No Teams or players are grandfathered to play on other teams. All previous grandfather clauses and exemptions have expired.
7. A team shall consist of at least 4 females. The pitcher or catcher must be female. Also there will be two females playing the infield and two playing the outfield.
8. Games will run 50 minutes. The inning in progress will be finished.
9. The order of batting remains the same for each inning. The batting order continues where it is left off at the end of the last inning.
10. Outfielders will remain behind a 200 line until the crack of the bat.
11. If the eligibility of a player is questioned (i.e., alumni status, proof of marriage/common law marriage) proof of identification and eligibility must be presented to play (such as valid driver's license with same address as the spouse or joint checking account).
12. There will be a \$50.00 charge paid at the beginning of a formal protest, and then both playing teams roster will be verified. Any team involved in a protest found to have an illegal player, will forfeit that game. The final decision will rest upon the Tournament Director or M.A.S.T. officers.
13. No alcohol allowed in the dugout during the games. Players who are impaired by alcohol will not be allowed to play.
14. Players are playing at their own risk; MAST is not responsible for injuries or accidents that occur during the Tournament.
15. All balls used in tournament play must be purchased from the MAST committee the weekend of the event and must bear the committee mark for that particular event.
16. Foul or vulgar language will not be tolerated in the stands or on the fields of play. It is the intent of M.A.S.T. to maintain a family type of atmosphere for all to enjoy. Loud obscene language is grounds for removal from the tournament and the park.
17. **No specific reason is required to disqualify a Team that in any way circumvents the intent of the Tournament Director and/or the Tournament Rules. We expect each class to support the Tournament and the intent of the rules. Because various actions over the previous tournament years have caused issues (roster issues, alcohol issues, sportsmanship issues), each class is expected to declare, in writing and in advance, all anticipated actions and/or activities during the Tournament weekend for specific written approval from MAST. Failure to request/obtain specific written approval is cause for disqualification.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR CO-REC TEAM

The restrictions placed on each sex during a Co-Rec softball game are as follows:

$$1 \leq \# \text{ of men} \leq 6$$

$$4 \leq \# \text{ of women} \leq 9$$

$$8 \leq \# \text{ of players} \leq 12$$

These are valid combinations. The normal Co-Rec batting order will alternate male and female batters. The rules for men batting back to back will still apply to men except as noted, but not to women batting back to back.

* 1 woman and 1 man EP, 2 women in the infield, 2 women in the outfield, 1 woman pitching or catching.

** 2 women in the infield, 2 women in the outfield, 1 woman pitching or catching.

*** The maximum number of men allowed in the infield is 2 and the maximum number of men allowed in the outfield is 2. NOTE: The infield is defined as 1st base, 2nd base, 3rd base, and shortstop. The pitcher and catcher are not considered infield positions.

**** The maximum number of men allowed in the infield is 2 and the maximum number of men allowed in the outfield is 2. Only 9-people are allowed to bat. There will not be an automatic out charged when the male back-to-back batters occur at the bottom of the batting order (e.g., when 1 following 9 or 9 following 8 are both male batters).

Batting order for 4 women and 6 men, or vise versa.

2. Woman
3. Man
4. Man
5. Woman
6. Man
7. Woman
8. Man
9. Man
10. Woman

When using this line up, additional batters (designated hitters) shall consist of one male and one female.

Because various actions over the previous tournament years have caused issues (roster issues, food issues, alcohol issues, sportsmanship issues), each class is expected to declare, in writing and in advance, all anticipated actions and/or activities during the Tournament Weekend for specific written approval from MAST. Failure to request/obtain specific written approval is cause for disqualification.
